**Grower's tip:**

- **Never let it sit in water.** Moist soil is good—soggy soil is not.
- Potting into a **slightly bigger container** reduces how often it needs watering.
- Very little fertilizer is required due to its slower growth rate.
- In lower light, watering frequency drops—wait longer between waterings.

**Pairs well with:**

Low-growing accents such as Aglaonema, short Dracaenas, Pothos, and other shade-tolerant underplantings that highlight the Kentia's tall, flowing canopy.
