-  **Forgiving Water Needs (With One Key Tip!):** Allow soil to dry between waterings. Compacta is sensitive to salt buildup due to calcium in water, so periodic leaching is recommended to flush excess salts from the soil and prevent tip burn.
-  **Rich, Timeless Appearance That Holds Its Color:** The deep green foliage retains its color even in low light, reinforcing Compacta's reputation as a dependable, professional-grade interiorscape plant.

Routine inspection, proper watering, and periodic soil leaching will keep this plant performing at its best for years. Compacta is a true statement piece and crowd pleaser!






Grower’s tip:

- Don’t overwater. Let soil dry between waterings
- Periodically leach soil completely to remove excess salt buildup
- Stake canes as needed to maintain upright structure
- Feel free to repot; very tolerant.
- Performs best in low to medium light
- Trim brown edges with a razor
- Use leaf shine to clean the leaves

ZZ Plant, Aglaonema, Pothos, Philodendron, compact palms, and low dracaena varieties that complement Compacta’s tight form and architectural presence.
