-  **Maintains Structure with Moderate Growth:** Like many dracaenas, Lemon Lime grows at a steady, manageable pace. This controlled growth allows the plant to maintain its shape and proportion for extended periods, making it well suited for commercial installations and long-term interior placements.
-  **Thrives in Low to Medium Light:** Dracaena Lemon Lime performs well in a range of indoor lighting conditions
 - *Low light:* Maintains structure but color may soften slightly
 - *Medium light:* Ideal for vibrant variegation and fuller foliage
 - *High light:* Tolerated, but bright indirect light is best to prevent leaf stress
-  **Low-Maintenance Water Needs:** Lemon Lime prefers to dry slightly between waterings and performs best when the soil is not kept constantly wet. Overwatering is the most common issue,

so allowing the soil to dry helps maintain healthy roots. Occasional leaf tip browning can occur but is easily managed with proper watering.

-  **Bright Foliage That Lifts Interior Spaces:** One of Lemon Lime's most appealing features is how its bright foliage naturally reflects available light, helping interior environments feel fresher and more vibrant. The striped leaves add depth and contrast that pairs beautifully with darker green foliage plants.

Additional Information:

Dracaena Lemon Lime is valued for both its durability and decorative foliage. Like most dracaenas, it performs best when protected from excessive moisture and extreme lighting changes. Pest pressure is generally low, though spider mites can occasionally appear in very dry environments. Regular inspections and proper watering practices help keep the plant healthy and vibrant.






Grower's tip:

- Don't overwater. Allow soil to dry between waterings
- Use a razor blade to gently remove any leaf tip browning
- Medium light helps maintain the brightest variegation

Pairs well with:

Compact palms, Aglaonema, Philodendron, Epipremnum (Pothos), Zamioculcas zamiifolia (ZZ), and darker green dracaena varieties that contrast beautifully with Lemon Lime's bright foliage.
