Grower's tip:

- Place in low to medium light for longest-lasting performance
- Lower light helps keep the plant cooler and reduces spider mite activity
- Extremely water tolerant and adaptable to different watering routines
- Spray foliage periodically with water to help suppress spider mite eggs
- Neem oil can also help smother mites if needed
- Avoid excessively hot, bright conditions whenever possible

Pairs well with:

Ficus, Dracaena, colorful tropical foliage, and taller canopy plants that provide filtered shade. Aspidistra works especially well as an underplanting or filler plant beneath larger structural specimens.
